Re: Our Client: Orlando Metropolitan Bridge Center, Inc. ("OMBC")

To Whom It May Concern:

Please be advised that the undersigned attorney and the above-referenced law firm have the honor of representing Orlando Metropolitan Bridge Center, Inc.

Respectfully, please accept this letter as our official demand that your committee, and each of you individually, cease and desist from making any additional slanderous or defamatory statements about Orlando Metropolitan Bridge Center, Inc. (OMBC) and/or its principals.

We respect your committee's right to form and your freedom of speech. However, your committee has absolutely no standing legally whatsoever to attempt to effectuate policy change at OMBC. None of you, respectfully, are members of the Board of Directors, nor are you officers of this non-profit corporation.

OMBC understands your belief that OMBC would be better run as an entity operated by the player membership, that is individuals who engage in playing bridge at OMBC. With respect, the Board of Directors does not agree with you. We understand you believe it is a conflict of interest for game proprietors to sit on our Board. We disagree. Proprietors have every incentive to try and minimize the fees they have to pay to OMBC that are in turn passed on to players.

OMBC was incorporated in 1988 as a non-profit company, and when the Articles of Incorporation were filed, they provided that the entity would be operated by its "members." That does not mean legally, and any lawyer with whom you consult on this issue will confirm this, that the concept of OMBC was that it would be operated by the players who engage in playing bridge at OMBC. The members legally of a non-profit corporation are the equity owners of the entity, and in the case of OMBC are the individuals who initially formed the entity back in 1988. That is none of the existing players. A bridge player is not a member of a non-profit company. Legally, the terms have completely different meanings.

OMBC recognizes that other bridge clubs are run differently from it. It understands that some bridge clubs are in fact governed and managed by the player membership. That is simply not the case in this non-profit company and never has been.

OMBC recognizes that on March 2, 2015, there was an amendment to its Bylaws that provided the bondholders would be the members of the entity. Please understand that the Bylaws are now being amended *ab initio* to provide instead that there will be no members, *i.e.*, equity owners, of this non-profit company. This is specifically allowable under Florida Statutes, and any lawyer with whom you consult will verify same.

OMBC has obtained an expert opinion from a tax consultant that it is in compliance with all applicable IRS rules and regulations from its inception to date.

OMBC is a valid non-profit corporation in the State of Florida and is validly running. It is therefore in complete compliance with its lease with the City. Please understand if you continue to make any statements to the contrary to anyone anywhere, this will be met with legal action. We respectfully demand you cease and desist from any such defamatory statements and that you retract any made to date. Likewise, should you contact the United States Internal Revenue Service, or OMBC's landlord, and attempt to instigate investigations into the tax and legal status of OMBC, you will first learn that OMBC has violated no tax laws and is currently in good standing as a non-profit corporation in the State of

Florida, and the result of such defamatory actions by you will be an immediate lawsuit.

OMBC has lost membership because of your activities. OMBC respectfully expects your committee to disband and/or stop any further defamatory misstatements about the company.

Should you wish to contact the undersigned and discuss any issues regarding the management of the company in good faith, we will accept that inquiry, but please know it is the intention of OMBC to prosecute any further tortious actions by your committee to the fullest extent allowable by law. Please also understand that your committee is not a formalized, incorporated entity in this state which means that if OMBC files a lawsuit, it will be filed against each and every one of the "members" of this committee, individually, seeking damages against each one, jointly and severally.

Our expectation is that this fully resolves this matter. This company is governed by its Board of Directors in accordance with its Bylaws, is in good standing and is operating within the allowable ambit of its Bylaws. This letter will also respectfully constitute official demand for a retraction of all defamatory statements made by your committee to date pursuant to Florida Statute 770.01 which is a necessary pre-condition precedent to any lawsuit for defamation or slander under Florida law.

In an email dated May 13, 2015, your committee informed our Board you had "consulted" with the ACBL's chief attorney. Within one week of the date of this letter please provide the name and contact information for this individual or instead confirm you never did speak with any such individual. Please govern yourselves appropriately.
